

*Psychiatrist can bill the proper testing code from **96101** to **96103** in addition to **90801**. Most of the Psychiatrist utilizing CliniCom today use **96101** and **90801**. The CliniCom report provides the necessary documentation to support the use of both codes.*

**96101:** Psychological testing (includes psychodiagnostic assessment of emotionality, intellectual abilities, personality and psychopathology, e.g., MMPI, Rorschach, WAIS), per hour of the psychologist's or physician's time, both face-to-face time administering tests to the patient and time interpreting test results and preparing the report

- Average reimbursement Boston: Medicare (\$86.08) and Orlando: Medicare (\$84.42)

**96102:** Psychological testing (includes psychodiagnostic assessment of emotionality, intellectual abilities, personality and psychopathology, e.g., MMPI and WAIS), with qualified health care professional interpretation and report, administered by technician, per hour of technician time, face-to-face

- Average Reimbursement: Boston: Medicare (\$54.74) Orlando: Medicare (\$49.67)

**96103:** Psychological testing (includes psychodiagnostic assessment of emotionality, intellectual abilities, personality and psychopathology, e.g., MMPI), administered by a computer, with qualified health care professional interpretation and report

- Average reimbursement: Boston: Medicare (\$48.99) Orlando: Medicare (\$45.04)

**90801:** Psychiatric diagnostic interview examination

- Average reimbursement: Boston: Medicare (\$158.37) and Orlando: Medicare (\$128.09)
